Tel numb – number where call should be forwarded

#### **Cancel**

#21#

## - Call Forward on Busy

#### **Assignment**

\*22\*Tel numb#

#### Cancel

#22#

# - Call Forward on No Answer

#### **Assignment**

\*61\*Tel numb#

#### **Cancel**

#61#

## - Abbreviated Dialing

#### **Assignment**

\*51\*AB\*xx#, where

AB - short code from 00 to 99,

xx – telephone number that you wish to dial with short code.

#### Cancel

#51\*AB#

## **Check**

Pick Up, dial \*\*AB (short number)

## - Password Dialing

## <u>Assignment</u>

\*34\*xxxxB#, where

xxxx - 4 password digits (default 1111),

B – call destination type to protect dialing (1,2,3), where

1 – all destination protected (exception – emergency numbers)

2 – Intercity and International

3 - International

#### Cancel

#34\*xxxxB#

# - Password Change

(to dial destination)

\*30\*xxxx\*yyyy#, where

xxxx - old password (default 1111)

yyyy – new password (user choice)

## - Call Waiting

#### **Assignment**

\*43#

#### **Cancel**

#43#

During talk of A with B, when A is dialed by C, – while talking the user A hears short beeps in phone (like on mobile phone at "second connection"). On pressing "flash" (star) and

0 – user C gets signal "Busy", A and B talk continues;

1 – connection switches to users A and C, user B – on hold;

2 – return to user B.

## **IMPORTANT!**

Services should be assigned / canceled only via tone dial. If impulse dial is on – assignment / cancel do no work!
